

## Making a Jewelry Box

**Students should have a reasonable knowledge of table saw operation.**

In this three session class you will make your own jewelry box under the guidance of an expert. Charlie will lead you through the process of designing your project, select the wood for the effect you want, size the material, cut precisely mitered corners, assemble the box, cut the top free, apply a finish and install the hinges. Other options such as making decorative corner feathers will also be covered. This is a great opportunity to add to your woodworking skills in several ways, learn just how valuable a tablesaw sled really is and go home with a beautiful box.



**Materials:** 3 options are available



For \$25 the materials fee includes jewelry box lumber and a pair of quality solid brass (Brusso) hinges<sup>2</sup>

For \$18 the materials fee includes hinges only (you provide your own lumber)<sup>3</sup>

For \$ 0 you provide your own lumber and hinges ( materials list available upon request)
